ALPHA PHI ALPHA FRATERNITY, INC. WAS THE FIRST INTERCOLLEGIATE GREEK LETTERED FRATERNITY FOUNDED BY AFRICAN AMERICAN MEN, at Cornell University in Ithaca, NY on December 4, 1906. Iota Lambda Chapter, the Indianapolis Alumni Chapter was founded in April of 1922. The Fraternity's national program on education dates back to 1919, with the introduction of its "Go to High School, Go to College." campaign to increase the educational level of the African-American community.

The mission and objective of the fraternity is to stimulate the ambitions of both its members and the community and to prepare them for greater service to humanity, freedom, and dignity of the individuals; to encourage the highest and noblest forms of manhood and womanhood; and to aid the downtrodden in its efforts to achieve higher social, economic, and intellectual status.

Scholarship Criteria

This scholarship is extended to all graduating seniors attending an accredited high school throughout Marion County, Indiana. Scholarship amounts may vary and will be determined by the Fraternity representatives. To be considered for a scholarship, the student **MUST** be accepted as a full time freshman for the fall school term of 2010 at an accredited college or university. The scholarship will be based on individual financial need, academic achievement, extracurricular activities, and participation in community service.

To apply for the scholarship, the student must:

- Have a cumulative grade point average of 2.7 or above.
- Submit a completed application. Applications may hand-printed or typed.
- Submit an official transcript indicating overall GPA and class rank. Transcripts must include all grades through the first semester of student's senior year.
- Submit two (2) original letters of recommendation. The first must be from an educator who can attest to academic knowledge of you as a student. The second letter may be from an employer, community leader, minister, or someone other than a family member who can attest to your character and any other significant achievements. The person making the recommendation must submit all letters to the fraternity in a sealed envelope with name written on the seal.
- Submit a biographical essay, not to exceed one type written page. This essay must include information about you and your family, your educational career goals, and your plans to achieve these goals.
- Submit copies of letters of acceptance from colleges and universities.
- Agree if selected as a semi-finalist, to complete a personal interview.

- Agree to attend Iota Lambda Black and Gold Scholarship Awards Reception (Locations to be determined). Seating will be provided for recipients and their parents, and guests.
- If under the age of 21, application must be certified by a parent or guardian.

The completed application and supporting materials must be received or postmarked by April 1, 2010. Any received or postmarked after that date will not be considered and returned to the applicant. Incomplete applications will not be considered and returned to the applicant.
